Millersville University at Penn State University - Harrisburg

On Tuesday, July $18^{\text {th }}$, 2023, two employees and two students from Millersville University's Archives \& Special Collections visited their colleagues at the Archives and Special Collections at Penn State Harrisburg, Madlyn L.
